Before enrollment in any EAR/ECE/EDE courses listed on this Plan of Study, the student must have a cleared BCI & I (background check) at both the federal and the state levels.

Education Technology students must obtain approval of the ECD Program Director at least six weeks prior to the start of class to enroll in EAR-5615.
