In Autumn 2012, Central Ohio Technical College will convert from the Quarter system (4 quarters per academic year) to the Semester system (2 Semesters and 1 Summer Session per academic year). Students entering COTC in Summer 2011, Autumn 2011, Winter 2012, Spring 2012, or Summer 2012 will begin their program in Quarters.

Students should meet with their Academic Advisor to map out individual paths to their degree.

A grade of C (2.00) or better is required in all Law Enforcement Technology courses to proceed in subsequent Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice, and Public Service courses and to graduate from the Law Enforcement Technology program.

Law Enforcement Technology students are required to take the COTC Placement Tests. Students assessing into the MTH-1200 Basic Mathematics course must satisfactorily complete 1200 Basic Mathematics by the end of the THIRD quarter of the Law Enforcement Technology program.

Credits earned from Pre-College courses including MTH-1200, MTH-1205, MTH-1206, PCE-1413, PCE-1430, PCE-1431, PCE-1432 and PCE-1433, will count neither for elective credit nor toward meeting the minimum credit hour requirements for graduation.
