A grade of "C" (2.00) or better is required in all courses to proceed in subsequent Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice and Public Service courses and to graduate from the Law Enforcement Technology program except the following courses: BHS-1397, BHS-1399, COM-1535, COM-1536, COM-1534 and the Non-Technical Elective - Lab Science and Non-Technical Elective - Mathematics Choices..
4. Law Enforcement Technology students are required to take the COTC Placement Tests. Students assessing into the MTH-1200 Basic Mathematics course must satisfactorily complete 1200 Basic Mathematics by the end of the **THIRD** quarter of the Law Enforcement program. Credits earned from Pre-College courses including MTH-1200, MTH-1205, PCE-1400, PCE-1413 or PCE-1423 will count neither for elective credit nor toward meeting the minimum credit hour requirements for graduation.
5. Students who have successfully completed the Ohio Peace Officers Training Council Certification through the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy will receive credit for those courses on this Plan of Study which are OPOTA courses. Please see a Law Enforcement Technology Faculty Advisor for possible course credit.
