5. Credit will be earned for the following courses: BHS-1345 Human Development, NUR-4233 Nursing I, NUR-4234 Nursing II, NUR-4235 Nursing III and NUR-4236 Nursing IV AFTER a grade of C (2.00) or better has been earned in NUR-4237 Nursing V. The combined GPA for that quarter must be 2.00 or better.
6. All applicants must hold current Ohio PN Licensure with medication endorsement in the State of Ohio.
7. L.P.N. to A.D.N. Transition course must be taken prior to or concurrent with NUR-4237 Nursing V. Credit for NUR-4240 L.P.N. to A.D.N. Transition course counts neither for elective credit nor toward meeting the minimum credit hours for graduation.
8. Prerequisites for admission to the A.D.N. program must be met prior to admission to the L.P.N. to A.D.N. program. All non-Nursing technology courses must be successfully completed prior to admission into the L.P.N.-A.D.N. Plan of Study.
