ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

International students who wish to be considered for admission to Central Ohio Technical College must submit the following:

1. Application for Admission
2. All pertinent high school and college transcripts with translation, if not in English.
3. Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). A minimum score of 550 is required on the paper version of the test, a minimum score of 213 on the computer version, or a minimum score of 79-80 on the internet-based TOEFL.
4. Evidence of financial support while in the United States.

*All documents must be submitted at least **three (3) months** prior to the start of the semester student plans to enroll. International students are assessed out-of-state fees and are required to be enrolled full-time (12+ credit hours).*

FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION

Each international student (F-Visa) applying for admission to Central Ohio Technical College must certify that adequate funds to pay for all school and living costs are available. See *Student Financial Statement* section.

FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION FOR APPLICANTS SPONSORED BY A PERSON, PEOPLE OR FAMILIES

Each person providing financial assistance to support your studies is required to complete and sign the Affidavit of Financial Support section *and* provide a certified bank statement that shows sufficient personal funds to cover the amount of support pledged. The bank statement should be provided in English and should include the current exchange rate for one U.S. dollar.

FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION FOR APPLICANTS SPONSORED BY A GOVERNMENT, AN AGENCY, OR AN ORGANIZATION

Each government, agency, or organization sponsoring a student should submit a letter, on official letterhead paper, containing the following information:
