Autumn 2016 Non-Credit Workforce Development EMS Classes

Emergency Medical Services Instructor Course – 60 hours = \$495 per person
(requires a minimum of 6 participants)

This course prepares participants for the Ohio EMS Instructor Exam. Must have 5 years of EMS experience, valid provider certification, and pass NREMT exam at current level within 3 years prior to start of class.

Paramedic Refresher Course – 48 hours = \$205 per person
(requires a minimum of 6 participants)

This course meets the Ohio Paramedic Refresher course completion requirements. Participants who successfully complete the course will receive 48 hours of refresher continuing education towards renewing their paramedic certification.
