Respiratory Therapy – Application Checklist

Application deadline: Autumn start*: May 1

This checklist is provided as a self-help guide to assist you in meeting all application requirements. All requirements must be completed by the application deadline:

	Complete the COTC admission application, www.cotc.edu/apply (this is not the program application).						
	Submit official high school transcript with graduation date or official GED transcript. High school seniors muss send a current transcript during their senior year and a final transcript after graduation.						
	Submit official transcripts from all career centers, colleges and universities attended past and current with GPA. ALL foreign transcripts (high school and colleges) must be evaluated by a NACES Member - https://www.naces.org/ .						
☐ Attend a mandatory Respiratory Therapy Technology Information Meeting (valid 12 months).							
	Complete any required remedial coursework with a grade of "C" or higher based upon the multiple measures placement policy. Courses may include co-requisite English and co-requisite College Algebra or Statistics.						
	Provide proof of completion with grade of "C" or higher of the following courses: O A full unit of high school Biology or Intro to Biology (BIO-010) and high school Chemistry or Intro to Chemistry Principles (CHEM-020), or higher college equivalents, or approved COTC transfer credit for Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO-130).						
 □ Complete Health Selection Exam - HESI A2 exams will only be available in-person. Exams can be taken a COTC campus. HESI scores are valid for 12 months. ○ Scores can be sent from any testing location if they meet the following criteria:

NOTE: FBI and BCI background checks are required upon notification of admission into the program (within one week). Final admission is contingent upon a cleared background check. CPR (EMS 100)- American Heart Association is required for clinical rotation. Drug screening, oral swab and TB skin test will be required through Licking Memorial Occupational Health.
