- Acceptance into the ECD Program: The student must meet with the ECD Program Director by October 30 of Autumn Quarter in the First Year of the Plan of Study or by six weeks prior to the start of Winter Quarter and enrollment in EAR-5615 Managing Children in Groups.
- ECD students must receive a grade of C (2.00) or better in ECD courses numbered EAR-5600 to EAR-5800 in order to continue in the ECD program and meet graduation requirements. In order to be eligible for EAR-5667 ECD Student Teaching and the Ohio Department of Education Pre-Kindergarten Associate Licensure, a grade of B (3.00) or better is required in all co-requisite field/methods courses (EAR-5641/EAR-5649, EAR-5631/EAR-5637, EAR-5621/EAR-5638). The instructor and ECD Program Director reserve the right to exercise professional judgement as the deciding factor in borderline cases.
