Prerequisite: Score of 85 or above on the Compass Reading Skills Test or 44 or above on the ASSET Reading Skills Test; CPR Certification recommended. Course is graded A-E.

This basic course covers all aspects of emergency medical care in the field, including equipment, controlling the situation, anatomy and physiology, medical and trauma emergencies, and advanced airwary control. This course at its successful completion allows the student to take the national registry exam to become certified at the EMT-Basic Level.
