The Basic Police Academy has been designed to meet the requirements of the Ohio Peace Office Training Council for Police Academies. There are specific admission requirements which must be met before a student will be admitted to this program. Successful graduates of this program will be recommended to take the state certification examination. Cadets that successfully complete this program will receive a letter of completion, for open enrollment students, or a certificate, if a commissioned officer from OPOTC and will be eligible to gain employment as a police officer, deputy sheriff, or armed security officer.

This Certificate program runs approximately 22-25 weeks during the evening hours (5 to 9 p.m.) Monday through Friday. Some weekends are required for blocks of firearms and driving training. All cadets are required to have a physical examination and a fingerprint check completed *at least 21 days prior to the start of each academy (No cadets will be accepted after this deadline)*. The physical examination WILL BE AT THE CADET'S EXPENSE. Fingerprint checks are required for <u>ALL</u> CADETS (persons convicted of a felony or domestic violence are not eligible for this program). Fingerprint cards are provided by the Academy only (see Program Director). Uniform expenses will be borne by the cadet.

Interested students must submit a completed COTC Application form with a non-refundable Application Fee of \$20 (contact the COTC Gateway-Admissions Office for additional admissions requirements). Cadets pay standard per credit hour tuition carges as set forth by the College (Listing of tuition fees available from the Gateway Admissions Office). Students will also be charged for Student Liability Insurance (\$35 one-time charge) and ammunition (currently \$200 one-time charge); ammunition prices are subject to change without notice due to price changes by the manufacturer. Individually purchased ammo will not be permitted on the range during class.

The Ohio Revised Code, Administrative Code Rule 109:2-1 provides: 1) for the power of the School Commander to enact rules and regulations which establish a higher standard of training than the minimum required; and 2) for the <u>termination</u> of the services of unsatisfactory students during or upon completion of the prescribed training period.
