## PRE-ADMISSION COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR NURPN.1YR program

The One-Year Certificate program in Nursing Technology, Practical Nursing a selection-based program, meaning a student must APPLY to the program and then be SELECTED into the program before being able to meet graduation requirements. The following COTC courses (or their equivalents) must be completed prior to being admitted into the NURPN.1YR program. All courses must be completed with a grade of C (2.00) or better.

1. BIO-1705 Introduction to Biology (5 credit hrs)

2. MTH-1205 Introduction to Algebra (5 credit hrs)

All Applicants to the this Plan of Study must first successfully meet admission criteria set forth by COTC.

A grade of C (2.00) or better is required for all courses listed on this Plan of Study in order

to continue in and graduate from the Practical Nursing Certificate program.

All Nursing courses must be followed in sequence according to this Plan of Study.

Policies of the Nursing Technology, One Year Certificate in Practical Nursing program which are unique in regard to admission, re-admission, grading and promotion are available in the Student Handbook, Division of HealthTechnologies.

PLEASE NOTE: Students who desire to pursue an Associate Degree in Nursing Technology (Registered Nursing), are encouraged to take Human Anatomy and Physiology courses (BIO-1772 and BIO-1773) as a substitute for BIO-1745 Human Biology.
