Prerequisites for COTC courses are the responsibility of the student (See the COTC Web Page). A grade of C (2.00) or better is required for all courses listed on this Plan of Study in order to continue in and graduate from the Nursing Technology program.

Credit will be earned for the following courses, NURS-101 Introduction to Professional Nursing, NURS-107 Introduction to Pharmacology and NURS-108 Fundamentals of Nursing, AFTER a C grade (2.00) or better has been earned in NURS-200 L.P.N. to R.N. Transition. The combined G.P.A. for that semester must be 2.00 or better.

All applicants must hold current unencumbered Ohio PN Licensure with medication endorsement in the State of Ohio.

Prerequisites for admission to the A.D.N. program must be met prior to admission to the L.P.N. to A.D.N. program. All non-Nursing technology courses must be successfully completed prior to admission into the L.P.N. to A.D.N. Plan of Study

All Nursing (NURS) courses must be followed in sequence according to this Plan of Study.

Policies of the Nursing Technology program which are unique in regard to admission, re-admission, grading and promotion are available in the Nursing Student Handbook, Division of HealthTechnologies.

The student who successfully completes the courses listed below on this Plan of Study with a C grade (2.00) or better in each course will earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing Technology and be eligible to sit for the state licensure examination for a Registered Nurse in the State of Ohio.
