

The summer semester numbers are complicated by a change in how College Credit Plus Option A (CCP-A) students are counted. This option is defined as high school students taking a COTC course in their high school from their high school instructor. In the past, these students were counted in the summer semester, but, for 17SP, were counted in spring semester. Therefore, this student sub-group is not included in the institution's population, making comparisons to last year inconsistent.
