

Spring 2024 Commencement

Time and Place – The Commencement Ceremony, for students who earned degrees and/or certificates during spring 2024, will be held Friday, May 3, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. in the Adena Hall Gymnasium on the Newark campus.

Commencement Check-in – Check-in will take place in Room 130 of Adena Hall beginning at 5:00 p.m. and must be completed by 5:45 p.m. *Please do not be late.* Signs will be posted to direct you to the correct room for your major after you check in.

Parking – Graduates should park in the Reese Center or Founders Hall parking lots.

Rehearsal – Rehearsal will take place Wednesday, May 1, 2024, in the Adena Hall Gymnasium. Rehearsal check-in will begin at 4:30 p.m., rehearsal will start at 5:00 p.m. and will last approximately one hour.

Tickets – Starting April 3, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., you may pick up your initial allotment of five (5) tickets at the Newark Gateway Office by presenting your photo ID. Unclaimed tickets will be made available to other graduates at the end of commencement rehearsal. If you are not able to pick up your tickets during the specified time frame, you may designate another person to pick those up for you by emailing the student records office at cotcrecords@mail.cotc.edu from your COTC email. This person will be required to present their photo ID.

Commencement Program Inclusion – Your name will not appear in the commencement program if you have instructed COTC not to release your "Directory Information". Student Records will provide you with your directory release status in email communications. To change your directory release status, please submit a "[Personal Data Change Form](#)".

Diploma and Certificate Distribution – Digital diplomas and certificates will be available via text and/or your COTC student email four to five weeks after the end of the semester. Printed diplomas and certificates will be mailed out by Parchment Award® and should arrive 15 to 20 business days after that. Be sure Student Records has your current mailing address and cell phone number. You can check your contact information and make any needed changes in Student Planning by selecting User Options then User Profile.

Financial Holds – If you have a financial hold or have not completed loan exit counseling (student loan recipients only), you will not receive your diploma or certificate. Name Verification – If you would like to verify that your name is spelled correctly for the commencement program and your diploma, please email cotcrecords@mail.cotc.edu.

- COTC is honored to provide you with a red, white, & blue cord to wear as part of your graduation regalia. Cords can be picked up at commencement check-in. If you have any questions, contact the Student Records Office at cotcrecords@mail.cotc.edu.

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Academic Regalia – All students participating in the ceremony are expected to wear a black cap and gown. Caps, gowns, and tassels can be ordered [here](#) until midnight April 7 and are also available in the Newark campus bookstore. We recommend that you purchase these as soon as possible to be assured the bookstore has what you need. Graduation announcements may also be purchased from the bookstore. A limited supply of gowns, and a very limited supply of caps are available to borrow on a first-come first-served basis to students who prefer not to purchase one. If you would rather borrow a gown, please make this request, including your height, by emailing the student records office cotcrecords@mail.cotc.edu.

Listed below are the only additions to the black cap and gowns permitted during the commencement ceremony.

- **Caps can be decorated** *in reference to your major*. Nothing profane, inflammatory, discriminatory, or dangerous will be permitted.
- **Honors Students** will be given a gold tassel at commencement check-in. To qualify, a student must have a cumulative GPA (grade point average) of 3.500 or higher.
- **High School Options students** (any student who took COTC classes while still in high school) will be given a green and white cord at commencement check-in.
- **Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society members** may wear their gold PTK stole. No other PTK accessories are permitted during the commencement ceremony. PTK stoles can be purchased using the [Student Life - Student Organizations](#) payment page. The *Student Organization* is PTK, and the *Payment Amount* is \$30.00. You may pick up your stole in the Office of Student Life located in room 226 of the Warner Center by showing your email receipt. If you have any questions about this process, please contact Student Life at 740-364-9578.
- **Alpha Delta Nu members** may wear the apricot cords received at their pinning ceremony.
- **Lambda Nu members** may wear the green and maroon cords received at their pinning ceremony.
- **Health Science Technology students** may wear the pins received at their pinning ceremony.
- **Military Personnel and Veterans** will be given a red, white, & blue cord at commencement check-in.

Guests – All guests should be in their seats by 6:20 as doors will close promptly at 6:25. Anyone arriving after 6:25 may be required to remain in the lobby until after the procession has completed.

Sign language interpreting – Sign language interpreting will be provided during the ceremony.

Accessible Seating – Due to limited space, only one person may accompany a guest who requires accessible seating in the special seating area during commencement. For other accessibility needs, please contact the Office for Disability Services at 740-755-7755.

Photographs – Cap and gown portrait photographs will be taken as you receive your diploma cover on stage and immediately after the ceremony as you are exiting the gymnasium.

Videotaping – A video of the ceremony will be hosted on COTC's YouTube channel, and a link will be provided on the COTC Homepage.

Commencement Photo/Video Release – By participating in or attending the commencement ceremony, you and your guests understand that COTC will be photographing and video recording the ceremony. The ceremony will be live-streamed on YouTube or other social media channels, and COTC may use video and photos from the commencement ceremony on college webpages, future publications, or media releases.
