

## Definitions of Crimes

**Murder** - Purposely cause another's death

**Robbery** - Using force or threatening the immediate use of force in attempting or committing theft

**Aggravated Assault** - Knowingly cause serious physical harm to another, causing or attempting to cause physical harm to another by use of a deadly weapon

**Assault** - knowingly or recklessly causing or attempting to cause physical harm to another

**Burglary** - By force, stealth or deception trespassing in an occupied, temporary, or permanent structure with the purpose of committing theft or any felony

**Motor Vehicle Theft** - The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle

**Rape** - Engage in sexual conduct by force or threat of force; for the purpose of preventing resistance, offender substantially impairs victim's judgment or control by giving any drug/intoxicant secretly or by force, threat of force, or deception. Victim need not prove physical resistance.

**Non-Forcible Rape** - Unlawful, non-forcible sexual conduct to include the crimes of Incest--non-forcible sexual conduct between persons who are related to each other within the degrees wherein marriage is prohibited by law; and Statutory Rape--non-forcible sexual conduct with a person who is under the statutory age of consent.

**Liquor Law Violations** - Violations of laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, sale, purchase, transportation, possession or use of alcoholic beverages.

**Drug Abuse** - Violations of laws prohibiting the production, distribution and/or use of certain controlled substances and the equipment or devices utilized in their preparation and/or use.

**Weapons** - Violations of laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, sale, purchase, transportation, possession, concealment or use of firearms, cutting instruments, explosives, incendiary devices or other deadly weapons.
