**Two Year Plan of Study for the Associate of Applied Science Degree in
Law Enforcement Technology**

- Courses listed on this Plan of Study may have prerequisites; please see the Course Description Section on the COTC Web Page (COTC Current Students Tab).
- Courses highlighted on this Plan of Study are offered only once a year in the Quarter indicated; courses not highlighted on this Plan of Study may or may not be offered more than once per year.
- A grade of "C" (2.00) or better is required in all Law Enforcement Technology courses to proceed in subsequent Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice and Public Service courses and to graduate from the Law Enforcement Technology program.
- Law Enforcement Technology students are required to take the COTC Placement Tests. Students assessing into the MTH-1200 Basic Mathematics course must satisfactorily complete 1200 Basic Mathematics by the end of the **THIRD** quarter of the Law Enforcement program. Credits earned from Pre-College courses including MTH-1200, MTH-1205, MTH-1210, PCE-1400, PCE-1413 or PCE-1423 will count neither for elective credit nor toward meeting the minimum credit hour requirements for graduation.
- Students who have successfully completed the Ohio Peace Officers Training Council Certification through the Ohio Peace Officers Training Academy will receive credit for the courses taught in quarters 5 and 6 of the Law Enforcement Technology Plan of Study. Please see the Director of the Institute for Public Safety for information on how to receive course credit.
- LE Quarters 5, 6 & 7 require acceptance into the OPOTA Academy.**

In Quarter #7 of this Plan of Study, students will elect to follow one of three Option Paths, with required courses for each Option Path listed below. Only students who have successfully completed the OPOTA may enroll in the Advanced Patrol and Investigations Option or the Homeland Security Option. Any student enrolled in the Law Enforcement Technology program may elect to enroll in the Correctional Management Option Path. Financial Aid/Veterans Affairs students must meet with Financial Aid Advisor prior to Quarter 7.
