Note: The student is solely responsible for the completion of these requirements and for the timely submission of the Radiologic Science Technology Application Form. **May 15, 2022 is a Sunday. Please make arrangements to meet with an Advisor for the application before close of business, 5pm Friday May 13, 2022.**

- COTC College Application for Admission
- Complete remedial coursework (if required) prior to submitting the application. Pre-college courses include Intro to Biology, Intro to Chemistry, and co-requisite English and Statistics.
- Official high school transcript with graduation date indicated **or** If not a high school graduate, a copy of G.E.D. scores and certificate and high school transcript are required. High school seniors must send a current transcript during their senior year **and** a final transcript after graduation
- Send all previous and current college and career center official transcripts with GPA indicated directly to the Gateway Student Records Office. An official evaluation report must be received from an approved member of NACES for all International transcripts (high school and college).
- Attendance to a Radiologic Science Information Meeting. (Valid within 12 months of application deadline)
- Waived for 2022 application deadline** - Documentation of observation hours* (Radiology Science 8 hrs.), **and** evaluation form from each observation site/visit, (**All** valid within 12 months of application deadline) ***No more than 4 hours in an outpatient facility**
- Completion of College Algebra (MATH 140) or college equivalent to apply with a grade of "C" or better.
- Proof of a full unit of high school Biology **or** Intro to Biology and high school Chemistry **or** Intro to Chemistry Principles, **or** higher college equivalents, **or** approved COTC transfer credit for Anatomy & Physiology I, all with a grade of C or better is required before the application deadline date.
NOTE: CPR (EMS 100)- American Heart Association is required for clinical if selected into the RAD program.
- Official scores of the ATI TEAS 6.0 test. (Valid within 12 months of application deadline)
- FBI background check must be completed **immediately** (within one week) once the student is notified of admission into the program. Admission is contingent upon a cleared background check. Completed Radiologic Science Program date-specific application (plus all documentation stated above) postmarked by the deadline. COTC recommends sending via Certified Mail.
