- Apply for free at cotc.edu/apply. Some programs may have additional requirements.
- Contact admissions at cotc.admissions@mail.cotc.edu
- Check your personal email (used to apply) for an official college communication on how to set up your COTC email account and mycotc student portal. Check your COTC email daily for important information.
- Contact Mark Rose at rose.1691@mail.cotc.edu to determine how you will finance your education. Misty will be your guide to military educational benefits such as the GI Bill™, Chapters: 30, 31, 32, 33 (Post-9-11), and 35. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov. COTC school code is 011046.
- Submit official transcripts: high school and/or GED, college and military to COTC Records Office: 1179 University Drive, Newark, Ohio 43055.
- **Confirm residency** status through your admissions representative.
- Register for Orientation: A link will be sent to your personal email (the email used to apply to COTC) to register for orientation. Future communications will be sent to your COTC email. When you have registered for orientation, our staff will review and confirm that you have completed this step.
- First Semester Registration: Once you've completed online orientation, you will work with an enrollment navigator to ensure all transcripts have been received and the financial responsibility agreement has been signed. You can attend a registration lab or have your enrollment navigator plan courses for you to self-register.
