PRE-ADMISSION COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR NUR.AAS program

- 4. (CHM-1700 Basic Chemistry and CHM-1710 General Organic Chemistry) or (CHM-1713 Chemistry Fundamentals)

All Applicants to the A.D.N. Plan of Study must first successfully meet admission criteria set forth by COTC.

A grade of C (2.00) or better is required for all courses listed on this Plan of Study in order

to continue in and graduate from the Nursing Technology program.

All Nursing courses must be followed in sequence according to this Plan of Study.
